## ORDER REGARDING CONTINUATION OF FINAL APPROVAL HEARING

As discussed at the close of the Final Approval Hearing on Thursday, October 21, 2021, the court will hear argument from the parties and the United States Secretary of Labor concerning issues the Secretary contends are raised by the proposed settlement under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974, 29 U.S.C. § 1001 et seq. Therefore, a continuation of the Final Approval Hearing is hereby scheduled to take place on Wednesday, October 27, 2021, at 10:00 a.m. Central Time. This hearing will take place REMOTELY, via Zoom video conference, and with telephone audio access provided for the public.

Those wishing to attend by Zoom SHALL make a request to the Special Master by 12:00 noon on Tuesday, October 26, 2021. Other interested parties, counsel, and the public may attend the hearing by listening to the hearing free of charge via telephone by dialing (844) 291-5489, access code 1007496.
